



INSTRUCTIONS TO AUTHORS

1st MENA Congress of Clinical Microbiology and Infectious Pathology

34th National STPI Congress

Hammamet 22 - 23 - 24 May 2025

All abstracts must be submitted electronically through the STPI website.

If you have an STPI account, please use your access settings. If you forget your password, click on the 'Recover my password' link. If you do not have an STPI account, you must [create a personal account](#). Creating an account allows you to submit all your abstracts, make corrections if necessary by pressing the 'edit' button, or delete them.

Abstracts can be submitted in [French](#) or [English](#). The deadline for submission is midnight on 28 February 2025. Notifications will be known from 15 April 2025.

Submitted abstracts will be accepted for presentation as [E-posters](#) or as [poster communications \(paper\)](#). If accepted, registration for the congress is compulsory for the first and/or second author by 18 May 2025 at the latest. Presentation certificates will not be issued if registration is not received by the deadline.

[Before starting the submission, please follow the instructions below:](#)

- Your abstracts must include the following 4 parts: Introduction, Patients and Methods, Results and Conclusion. The discussion will not be included in the abstract.
- Summaries of series studies will be submitted in the 'clinical studies' section. Summaries of clinical cases should be submitted under the heading 'clinical cases'.
- The title should be in lower case except for the first letter, for names or known abbreviations. Authors: Use only the initials of the first names in capital letters, followed by a full stop and then the surnames. Example: Mohamed Ben Mohamed: M. Ben Mohamed. The speaker's name must be followed by a star.
- The text must not exceed 350 words, including the names and addresses of the authors.

You can always modify or delete an abstract after submission. Submissions must be made in one go to avoid duplication.

N.B.: Failure to follow these instructions will result in the rejection of your abstract(s) and it will not be sent to the reading committee.
